

# Students with Special Needs

FRCS offers the following exceptional programs:

- Search and Teach: an early intervention program for young learners (K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade) with possible learning disabilities
- NILD: one-on-one educational therapy for students with learning difficulties who have experienced frustration and/or failure in school
- Resource: small group instruction is provided to students in need of intervention for specific gaps in academic skills
- Explore: program that meets the unique needs of gifted and talented learners by helping them develop their God-given abilities
- TLC (The Learning Center): program that offers a modified and differentiated curriculum to students with special needs

## The Learning Center

The TLC is an exciting addition to our campus! Students receive an education tailored to their needs and have the opportunity to be a part of regular class settings through electives such as P.E., art, music, chapel, and discipleship groups. If appropriate, a student may also participate in some regular academic classes.

A distinctive feature of the TLC is our pre-vocational and vocational program. Currently junior and senior high students run a thrift store on campus. After students gain work experience on the FRCS campus, our goal is to get them working in the community at a job that suits them.

Speech therapy is also offered on campus through Children's Advisory Network.
