

FACTS Family Online/ParentsWeb – Create a Parent Account

TO SET UP YOUR PARENTSWEB ACCOUNT:

Go to <https://logins2.renweb.com/logins/ParentsWeb-Login.aspx> in any browser
Enter **FRCS-CO** in the **District Code** field and click the **Create New ParentsWeb Account** link.



The password must be at least 6 characters long and must contain at least one number and letter. Remember to click the '**Save Username and/or Password**' button when you are done.
